Round Table Updates	 Suzanne from OW-numbers are growing and there is a wait list of 6 months for a transition worker. Suzanne assists with supports for clients including ODSP applications and addiction supports. Charmaine from the BNFC- hiring for 2 new Justice positions (Restorative Justice and Bail Supervision). Provided update on Project Safe Horizon committee-Human Trafficking. Offered posters with contact #'s for agencies to post. Marc from YJS- Marc from Probation: Is transferring to Manitoulin Island. Rebecca Hayward is returning from maternity leave and will hopefully return to this committee. Probation For the Future planning is looking at early intervention statistics and connecting with other agencies that will engage high risk youth at an earlier point hopefully resulting in preventative measures. Maegan from Salvation Army-Bail program has expanded to Bracebridge and partnering with Barrie Native Friendship Centre for Indigenous Bail Supervision Program. Kristen from E-Fry - no new updates Debbie from CMHA - Katherine Hunt starting March 29th as CMHA's Barrie Youth Court Support Worker. Drug Court: Deb and Evelyn went to observe Oshawa Drug Court. They have max 7 clients for their program. 	Lived experience person could not attend today's meeting.



	 CMHA will be offering Brief Counselling when Drug Court services start in Barrie. There will be weekly drug testing and either rewards or sanctions delivered for members of the Drug Court. Current status is that Karen Jokinen, Federal Crown has sent in application to the Government for approval of Drug Court services Jean-Marc from CMHA- Collingwood now has an ACT team. Katherine Hunt will assist in brokering the Section 34 assessments for youth when ordered. Tara from Busby-has been a very busy winter. Busby is hiring a new person to assist with case management. Jaime Lloyd from CMHA-as of March 31st; Alliston will be supported by York Region CMHA services. 	
Other Business	Workplans- Jean Marc submitted the annual 2017-18 Workplan. Some highlights include: We will try to replace a member from the same agency before recruiting new members, we will hear a minimum of 1 presentation from community partners (Jean Marc requested suggestions from members on speakers), will host a quarterly meeting, provide 100 Release From Custody Bags, sponsor 2 members from each committee for regional conference, sponsor 1 person from each committee for Provincial conference.
