Ted Beattie (CMHA) – Kim Cooke from Release from Custody Program has returned to her job position from Maternity leave. 4 new hires at the CNCC jail as Mental Health Workers. Youth probation has specialized funding for youth to see a Psychiatrist/Psychologist. Application process. One month turnaround. New Directions program through New Path services, services Youth found guilty of sexual offences. Tara Osment (Busby Centre) – Van was out of commission due to vandalism however has been repaired. Have hired new housing first case manager. Other new hires – Olivia Intensive Case manager. Tara Osment is a brief services 	

	worker along with Sue. Out of the Cold commences November 15, 2017. Central Intake for Out of the Cold will be at Busby Centre. 0800-0730 Monday to Friday. 0330 – 0730 weekends. Donations for Out of the Cold appreciated. Socks, blankets, sweaters, shoes and jackets. Gilbert Centre attends Busby Centre every Friday and will travel with the Outreach Van for that day. Recently Busby Centre has had a donation of new mattresses. Busby Centre will also take furniture. • Julie Reynolds (Barrie Police Service) –Citizen Police Patrol program will continue. A selection of 12 citizens will be selected to police residential streets. New program – Forensic unit policing – will focus on educating the public on forensics and other departments. Interested individuals may be from Police College or retired couples. Collaborative Barrie continues to meet twice weekly.
