The partnership includes online mini directories, <a href="#">Common Point Directories</a>, and a calendar is also planned for information about short term and one time services</p> <p>→ 211 answers the bilingual toll free Good2Talk telephone line, connecting callers to professional counselling and information and referrals for mental health, addictions and well-being to post-secondary students in Ontario 24/7</p> <p>→ ReportON- 211 answers a new toll free line for reporting suspected or witnessed abuse of adults with developmental disabilities, 24/7.</p> <p>→ Recently, suicide prevention initiative posted new signs along the railway and overpasses in Northumberland County including 211 as a way to connect callers to support services.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Karen, OPP</b> – Vulnerable Populations Registry self-subscribed by citizens with (Ex: dementia, mental health, etc....), includes information helpful to officers who are called to these locations/residences</li> <li>• <b>Alice, CGMH-Crisis</b>–Mobile crisis intervention team is in the works, and could include response to domestic situations.</li> <li>• <b>Lorianne, OPP</b>- A response team similar to COAST has been in place for two months. A crisis worker participates in a ride-a-long once a month, and is also educating OPP officers.</li> <li>• <b>Terri, P&amp;P</b>–Short staffed at Probation/Parole office. → Mentioned that the previous HSJC fundraiser to purchase an Autism service dog for a family has been successful</li> <li>• <b>Darcy, OW</b> – No updates.</li> <li>• <b>Blair, CMHA</b> – Busy Collingwood court</li> <li>• <b>Jean-Marc, CMHA</b> – New Release from Custody staff in Orillia, Christina Gilbert is replacing Kim Cooke on a parental leave and Barrie Youth Court staff, Ashley Strong left CMHA, currently interviewing internally to fill this vacancy</li> </ul>
