Regional HSJCC Update	 HSJCC Regional Conference is May 11th, 2017. Early registration went out and 2 spots are being subsidized 	



	for members of each committee. Darcy and Dawn are chosen to receive subsidy for Collingwood committee. All HSJCC work plans needed to be submitted by Jean-Marc by March 1 st , 2017 which was done. Next HSJCC regional meeting is March 27 th , 2017. CIT was held for Barrie Police week of Feb. 13 th , 2017. Regional work plan discussed. Summary: CIT, regional conference, meet 4 times per year, annual work plan/reports, find a consumer to join/sit at the regional level, 2 presentations at committee meetings per year (community partners), support projects (i.e. COAST requesting a past letter for funding purposes), sponsor 5 people to go to the provincial conference, if money left over – will look into other local projects. Mallory Holmes – Assessor/Navigator at DSO will be joining Regional HSJCC and will be travelling around the region to present to HSJCC local committees, as Jean-Marc is to schedule this with Mallory this year. Barrie received funding for a 3 month COAST pilot project. Brittanie– Opioid/Umbrellas CMHA: no waitlist currently. Helping out with Barrie waitlist Tuesdays. Terri – Probation & Parole: P&P have full staff again and new management. Case loads are at their lowest province wide but more intensive work (client & admin) Dawn- CSP: New management at CSP. Agency changed their operating name from "Consumer Survivor Project" to "Caring, Supporting, Participating Mental Health and Addictions Peer Support." Looking at re-vamping anger management program. Other Business	 Collingwood work plan discussed. Summary: 1) maintain local meetings quarterly. 2) Committee to support new OPP/Hospital partnership establishment.
