- Changes in Housing: City of Kawartha Lakes; supported contracts have long since expired
- Integrated Housing Model; Homeless Prevention funding pulled back, possibility of 50% staff elimination/layoffs; to be replaced by a general clerk without any experience in this field
- Will continue to fund on a monthly basis, currently funded programs
- A Place Called Home is negotiating for a Shelter Budget, hopeful; funding will be approved

<u>Emergency Seasoned Firewood</u>: several locations-volunteers cut and split; Chairs of the Food Banks want to be involved to assist
