- o In the MOHLTC *Patients First* discussion paper, it was noted that there was no mention of primary care in corrections, and it was suggested we consider ways to advocate for this neglected group.
- Fiona Kouyoumdjian and Terry McGurk drafted a letter to Minister Hoskins which was sent on behalf of the LHIN 4 Regional HSJCC. The letter is receiving support from the Provincial HSJCC as well.

Update on HSJCC Work Plan 2016/17 – Terry

- The Province has sent out a more structured Work Plan Template for all local committees to follow in their reporting. Chairs of the LHIN 4 Regional group have decided to do their reporting together, and have met to identify activities, timelines, outcomes, budgets and outputs for the next year.

Update on ABI Corrections Working Group – Terry

- HELPS Screening Tool work on this was delayed by potential strike action at HWDC, but things are returning to normal now
- <u>Data collection</u> local HSJCC database has been adapted so it can also pull data for ABI reporting
- ABI Resource Guide has been compiled and is awaiting approval to go to print. Hope to have it released by spring.
- ABI Work Plan is almost completed.
