

This program is the main point of contact for MNO Justice Programs.






How are Requests Reviewed

- 3. Resources provided to client






- Individuals can access the MNO Community Diversion Program as an alternative to traditional sentencing
- This program offers an alternative to sentencing for Indigenous Peoples, through the provision of services that promote conflict resolution and reintegration into communities.

What makes our model different from other diversion programs?

The Justice Council is made up of Métis Knowledge Keepers, Community members, and professionals.

The program can utilize in-house Métis focused support programs. Such as MNO Mental health and addictions, MNO Victim Services etc..



Restorative Justice Program Catchment Area



- Program has been available in Region 8 since 2018
- Now also available in Region 6
- Currently expanding across all Ontario
- Program may extend its reach based on Client's situation



Indigenous Criminal/Family Court Worker

The Indigenous Court Worker (ICW) is responsible for in-court and out-of-court support for both youth and adults in the areas of:

- 1. Family Law
- 2. Criminal Law
- 3. Child welfare

The ICW cannot provide legal advice but may act as an advocate who speaks on a person's behalf if they can't or won't speak for themselves while involved with the justice system.



Justice Community Support Specialist

- Works with Restorative Justice/Diversion Clients after Diversion/Sentencing
- Provides Support, Referrals to Internal/External referrals and assistance with the creation of client-led Action Plans








