Key Outcomes	Clients were able to communicate with their support team including case workers, lawyers, mental health supports, and other court related individuals. Clients were also able to call in to court when they were unable to attend in person (due to courthouse restrictions). HSJCC was able to provide access to food, hygiene, and
