PROVINCIAL HSJCC UPDATES

- The **CKE Committee** is looking to **recruit new members**. Regional and Locals are encouraged to bring this back to their tables to see if there is any interest in joining. Members can contact <u>Trevor</u> for more details.
 - The Committee is in the process of developing website forums. The first forum will be set up for Regional and Local HSJCCs chairs to improve communications between committees.
 - ➤ The Committee will be redesigning the HSJCC Network brochures over the summer.
- Trevor provided an update from the 2019 HSJCC Conference Planning Committee:
 - ➤ Registration details will be set over the next coming weeks. The hotel link has been provided on the <u>HSJCC website</u>.
 - > 70 abstracts were submitted for the conference. Submissions accepted into the conference will be notified in June 2019.
 - Regional and Local Chairs are encouraged to send the **sponsorship/exhibitor package** out to their members to look for potential sponsors.
- The **Police Hospital Transition Framework and Toolkit** were officially approved by both Minister Elliott and Solicitor General Jones:
 - A Provincial Education Forum will be hosted in Toronto on June 3rd by the Provincial HSJCC, the Ontario Chiefs of Police, the Ontario Hospital Association and CMHA Ontario.
 - Once the documents are publicly released, they will be circulated through the HSJCC network.
- An update was provided on the Older Adults and the Justice System Project:
 - The project advisory committee is working on a final draft of the **navigational guidebook to** be released in September 2019.
 - Members that have questions regarding the content and process of this project are encouraged to contact the <u>Secretariat</u>.
- Uppala presented an overview of the Survivors of Homicide Victims and Mental Health Collaborative Project led by the University of Toronto and CMHA Ontario:
 - ➤ The P-HSJCC will continue to receive updates on this project and will invite Dr. Sharpe to present to the table at a future meeting.
 - Members that are interested in joining the advisory committee can contact Uppala.
- **John Howard Society of Ontario (JHSO)** presented on their recent work within the Centre of Research, Policy & Program Development:
 - Currently, there are 4 priority areas: police records, health and mental illness, bail and remand & reintegration. Corresponding research reports can be found on JHSO's website.
 - New work focuses on the unmet civil legal needs of those involved in the justice system
 - > JHSO has expressed interest in joining the P-HSJCC as an ex-officio member
- 2018-2019 HSJCC Network Annual Reports are due to the Secretariat by June 1st, 2019.

- Justice for Children and Youth (JFCY) presented on an overview of their work and its alignment with the work of the HSJCC network:



- > JFCY provides child-centred legal services to enhance justice services for the most vulnerable clients across Ontario.
- > JFCY has expressed interest in **joining the P-HSJCC as an ex-officio member**.
