

P-HSJCC Meeting Highlights

January 21, 2020

PROVINCIAL HSJCC UPDATES

- The Secretariat provided a 2019-2020 P-HSJCC Financial Update:
 - > The P-HSJCC conference ran a higher deficit than expected, however we were able to cover outstanding costs by our contracted work with CMHA Peel Dufferin to support the development of a police-hospital transition protocol for Peel Region.
 - The P-HSJCC is able to move forward with all remaining workplan items for this fiscal year including in-person meetings and hosting a **Housing and Justice Forum** on February 26^{th,} 2020.
- Cathy Halovanic, ABI System Navigator, presented on some of the key issues surrounding **ABI** populations and the justice system.
 - Members discussed ways of improving existing resources for these unique populations while ensuring consistency of approach across the province. Members are encouraged to connect with <u>Cathy</u> for further consultation.
- Representatives from Legal Aid Ontario (LAO) spoke to some of their recent service changes and consulted with P-HSJCC members on how they can continue to improve services for our client populations.
 - ➤ LAO will continue to engage in consultations with the P-HSJCC around these issues.
- Representatives from the Ministry of the Solicitor General Correctional Services Division updated the
 P-HSJCC on their outreach efforts to connect corrections with Ontario Health Teams (OHTs). The goal
 is to build strong partnerships between OHTs and correctional services and increase awareness of
 justice involved individuals in the broader health care system.
 - ➤ Regional and Local HSJCCs who have an OHT in their area and have not yet consulted with corrections are encouraged to bring this to their table.
- The Ministry of the Solicitor General Institutional Services branch provided an update on the **Discharge from Distant Court Protocol** project.
 - The project is not on hold and is no longer being rolled out across the province. Regions are encouraged to move forward with their Red Bag pilots and contact the SolGen if they require any support in getting a pilot off the ground.
 - ➤ <u>Bill Chantler</u> has offered to share detailed information on **London's Red Bag pilot** and connect with any regions looking to develop a framework for their communities.
- The P-HSJCC has decided to strike an **Advisory Committee** to oversee the development of a **Persons** with Lived Experience Engagement Strategy.
 - ➤ Priority consideration will be given to persons with lived experience and representation from each of our 14 regions. Please contact <u>Tasha Rennie</u> if interested.
- The Secretariat held two Issue Management Sessions:
 - ➤ GAINQ3 Assessments in Correctional Institutions: The Ministries of Health and Solicitor General, and CAMH PSSP are working together to explore the issues around implementation of GAINQ3 training in correctional institutions and will report back to the P-HSJCC with any updates.
 - ➤ Dual Diagnosis and Justice Clients: The P-HSJCC would like the Secretariat to connect with Developmental Services Ontario and Community Networks of Specialized Care on this issue and provide updates at the March P-HSJCC meeting.



IMPORTANT ACTION ITEMS

- <u>ACTION</u>: The Secretariat will circulate all of the presentation slide decks from our guest speakers at the January 2020 meeting.
- <u>ACTION</u>: Bill Chantler will send the London Red Bag Pilot backgrounder to the Secretariat to circulate to the P-HSJCC.
- <u>ACTION</u>: Connex Ontario to conduct a scan of all dual diagnosis services available across the province and a list of residential treatment centres that accept justice involved clients and forward the information to the Secretariat.
- <u>ACTION</u>: The Secretariat to connect with Developmental Services Ontario and Community Networks of Specialized Care on the Dual Diagnosis and Justice issue. The Secretariat to provide updates to the P-HSJCC at the March meeting.
- <u>ACTION</u>: The Secretariat to look into alternative dates for the March 2020 meeting and advise P-HSJCC members.
