	<ul> <li>Base funded investments for 2021 include the following:</li> <li>\$6.55 million for Mobile Crisis Response Team across Ontario</li> <li>1.3 million for 5 new Court Transitional Case Managers with dedicated housing units attached</li> <li>\$5 million for Safe Bed program that are accessible to Police and MCRT</li> <li>\$2 million for Addiction Specialists to support people in and Safe Bed programs in Kenora and downtown Toronto East</li> <li>\$14 million for 504 Justice Support housing units (permanent housing for people from release from custody or diversion programs</li> <li>Funding letters have been submitted to the LHIN's but the rent supplement portion of the housing is directly funded by the ministry to be released to the agency. The housing letters are still being</li> </ul>
	approved. There are Communities of Practice for every MH & Justice funded program since 2017/18 (note there were programs before this date).
	Community of Practice include: • Release from Custody Workers • Justice Supportive Housing • Mental Health Court Support and Transitional Post Court Support • Safe Beds • Addiction Specialists • Mobile Crisis Teams (have not convened as of yet) There are also several Communities of Practice on the forensic side (some of which have been taken over by the community) including: • Forensic Transitional Case Managers • Transitional Rehabilitative Housing Program (TRHP)
