	• The P-HSJCC supports the initiation of an Anti-Racism committee to help guide the work of P-HSJCC and broader network moving forward.
	• Members agreed that this should be a standing committee that will continue to inform the work of the P-HSJCC.
	• The Secretariat is working on clarifying the language around working groups versus advisory committees in the P-HSJCC Terms of Reference. Changes will be presented to the P-HSJCC at the January meeting for approval.
	• The committee will require a Chair (usually from the P-HSJCC) or Co-Chairs (at least one from the HSJCC Network) and will be supported by the Secretariat.
	<u>ACTION</u> : The Secretariat will follow up with P-HSJCC members to nominate a Chair/Co-Chairs for the standing committee on addressing Anti-Racism across the HSJCC Network.
	<u>ACTION</u> : The Secretariat to send out a call out through the HSJCC mailing list for members interested in joining the Anti-Racism committee.
5) Urgent Response Access to First Responders for	Ryan Hodgson from the Ministry of Children, Community and Social Services presented an overview of the urgent response process for adults with developmental disabilities.
Individuals with Developmental Disabilities	 This service was announced to provincial police services in March 2019. SSome of the features in the process include an after-hour's access mechanism component, temporary housing, and in-home supports.
	 There was concern that police services and providers were not aware of this service in the North West Region.
	The Ministry will look into a second round of communication to ensure police services and service providers are aware of this available support service.
	There is an opportunity to facilitate this communication through the HSJCC Network.
