Regional Updates								
Peel: Christine DeVoy- Johnson Report inspired new focus on Risk, supported by CAMH. Purpose to reintegrate high-risk clients in to community. Peel will distribute the process and outcomes to all regional groups. London: Peter Aharan- Preliminary discussions with MAG regarding a drug court, still								

developing a workplan.

Central South: George Kurzawa- Begun hiring process for a release from custody coordinator for CNSC as response to the Report. Working with LHIN in response to their request for information contained in Report.

Halton Region: Garret LaFosse- Commencing 1/4 ly meetings with local Crown Attorney's; Oakville Trafalgar Hospital have funding to assist with mental health and psychiatric supports.

Simcoe: Jim Leveque- Have deferred regional forum in order to financially help participants to attend the Provincial Conference; Release from Custody program at CNCC going well.

York-S Simcoe: Jonathan King- Expressed nee to target services to specific mental health groups. Strategy to overcome shortage of psychiatric supports has been resolved with partnership of probation services; Regional Committee needs inspiration and focus.

Haliburton-Pine Ridge: -Gerry Fucile- Four local committees very active; Recent successful local Forum in Coburg stressing mental health issues.

Northwest: Maurice Fortin-The focus has been on the court and court support systems and trying to inform the regional committee about meaningful input into offences and dispositions and strategize next steps. Kenora is still underserviced and the work continues to develop local partnerships.

Northeast: Sandy Leith: LHIN has created a regional advisory panel to decide services and bed allocations locally. The region is part of a pilot program to initiate the use of OCAN- Ontario Common Assessment of Need across 7 areas; Training has been initiated to plan service needs led by the DD Guidelines and will report back on outcomes; Sault Ste Marie is developing a mental health court.

Champlain: Ongoing court transportation issue.

Ministry Updates

Ministry of the Attorney General: Curt Flanagan-Ministry visits to all regional HSJCC's continues; Planning stages for 3rd Attorney General Round Table-Mental Health

Ministry of Children and Youth Services: Brian Smegal, Planning continues for Youth Mental Health Court Worker Forum on June 23rd, 2009

Community Networks of Specialized Care: Provincial Rep- Liz Froese- 4 programs are being developed to (1) Dual Diagnosis Curriculum Sustainability; (2) Mental Health Transitions-provincial strategy to unblock beds; (3) Create Provincial Data Base; (4) Clinical Supports-identifying what exists and their needs; Project with CAMH to navigate DD System for crisis clients and health care professionals; The DD Guidelines are being distributed to all LHIN's. Liz will distribute Guidelines and Handbook: Working with Dual Diagnosed Offenders Vol # 2 to provincial HSJCC committee.

Ministry of Community Safety and Correctional Services: Chris Higgins for Sue Khowessah-Video Conferencing for fitness assessment being expanded to 3-4 new detention sites; Release From Custody program research indicates that there is a shortfall of staff at the detention centre level and MOH and MCSCS working to resolve issue.

Ministry of Health and Long Term Care: Chris Higgins- Minister of Health's Advisory Group URL will be provided to committee members; Court case resolves forensic matters-cut off of ODSP when in detention in partnership with MCSS; Chris will distribute case when available; Work will begin with MCSS at the IWG level with HSJCC regarding diversion for DD clients held in detention and returning to residential system.

OPP: Judy Alton- Competency Working Group: OPP have begun a pilot project training frontline officers training in mental health related issues.
