Jean-Marc and Debbie Bigelow attended a Mental Health Court Forum in Toronto in April, a report will be provided in late 2017. Red Bag Program is happening in Ottawa area (presented at last Provincial conference). Provincial HSJCC is advocating for this program – proposing three phases to expand in 2017-2018 Conference May 11th intended to have 110 attend including speakers and volunteers. - Drug court committee was formed and has been seeking approval for Barrie Drug Court, has now been accepted. Drug Court Support Services hoping to start end of 2017, as still need to work on this
- HSJS annual Program Review Day was held on May 18th, reviewed successes, challenges and goals
- CMHA's AGM held on June 19th
- Nurse Practitioner clinic has resumed. Donna offers services
 Wednesdays at 88 Mulcaster Office. Lula expected to return in September
- NS ACTT has a new psychiatrist, Dr. Joan Quinn starting in July

- Lots of work on Human Trafficking
- Jordan Decision mandates cases must be tried within certain time period has caused lots of ramifications. Is very rapid, many charges being stayed

Tom Sinclair, Barrie Police

- COAST Program Sep-Dec, 2016; 58 apprehensions, Jan-Mar, 2017;
 54 apprehensions. Has been a very valuable program all around.
 Working through partnerships to run COAST all year
- Wellness Coordinator is going on maternity leave, looking for contract replacement
- 3 persons with dementia have gone missing in the local area during the past week. All were found. This sort of incident is expected to increase by 200% over the coming years

Mary Martin, CNCC

- CNCC working to move people out of segregation as much as possible
- Have secured additional psychiatric hours approx.4.5hrs per week
- Has 2 new social workers, 5 new mental health nurses are currently undergoing security clearance
- Release from Custody review resulted in recommendations for new positions in province – 4 have been funded
- Provincial interdisciplinary committee formed to look at common issues. Currently reviewing Suicide Prevention
