CNCC – Mary Martin

- X9 mental health nurses positions but not all have been filled.
- X2 Social Worker vacancies, x1short term contract until August
- Government brought forward Correctional Services
 Transformation Act
 - Discusses segregation prohibiting, restrictions and limitations
 - Client living conditions and standards
 - Ministry of Health to take over some aspects of health care within corrections facilities

Georgian College - Karen Bell

- New Dean is settling in
- Currently involved in community work with youth centre
- Conference June 2 on Wellness presented by Dr Jean Clinton

Victim Witness Assistance Program - Shawn Pollock

Working with St John Ambulance bringing support dogs into court

OPP - Leslie Raymond, Jennifer Quigley

- CIT Training train the trainer session April 9 8-10 teams will attend. Will be funded regionally. Commitment for each region to hold x2 classes per year in each region. Next CIT in Barrie to be held in October
- Adapted Mental Health First Aid course for police officers.
 Plan going forward this will be a mandatory course for all officers includes 1.5 hour e-learning module and 1 day instruction

CMHA – Pamela Moon, Jean Marc Pelot, Himanshu Shah

- Working with Regional Partners on Coast and joined Police Mobile Response. Have been advocating for permanent Coast Program for 5 years or so. Will be presenting to LHIN tomorrow
- Ministry of Health has funded new Dual Diagnosis Court Support staff; Chelsea is new staff in Release from Custody. New program Forensic Supportive Housing Project provides rent subsidies and a worker for people transitioning from TRHP program as part of reintegration to community
- Jim Harris has left CMHA SC and is now with CMHA Ontario
- Himanshu is Director of Clinical Services has now joined this committee, replacing Jim Harris on this committee
- Nurse Practitioner, Luladay returned from mat leave, clinic is rolling with 20-30 new referrals monthly. Recently discharge
